Community support is critical at a time when FISH is seeing an over 20% increase in the number of people coming in for assistance. High food and housing costs, paired with the recent decrease in SNAP benefits, are making it even harder for low-income residents to make ends meet. One participant shared, "I love being able to go to FISH to pick up the needed groceries to help me survive. Everything has gotten so expensive. Without FISH, I don't know where I would be. I am truly grateful and blessed for their services."

One of the best ways to support Embracing Hope and make an impact in FISH's work to feed families and fuel hope is to become a sponsor.
